Errata

Page 152, first paragraph, first sentence

The phrase “high crown” should be “tall arrangement of hair”: This sculpture of Acuoye Guanyin (Sanskrit: Ajaya Avalokiteshvara, meaning invincible Avalokiteshvara) depicts a slender figure wearing a tall arrangement of hair and a tightly fitting lower garment, his bare upper torso decorated with jewels.

Page 204, dimensions

The size of this artwork is H. 127 cm x W. 129.5 cm

Page 213, last paragraph, first sentence

The word “painted” should be “pointed”: On the back of the Buddha are two projections originally intended to affix a large aureole (a pointed halo surrounding an entire body).
